

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

*This document contains all the information necessary to complete registration for the 2011/12 school year. **Please review it carefully.** All required forms must be printed, completed, and returned on the assigned registration day.*

Scheduling Issues – If students have a problem with their class schedule, they need to **speak with a counselor immediately after they pick up their printout at the August registration.** Our master schedule will allow very little flexibility in changing class choices that were made in the spring. Not all changes can be made, especially once the school year begins. It is, therefore, imperative that ALL requests for class changes be addressed during registration. Typically, these changes are ONLY for schedules that are inaccurate (missing class periods), for a class the student already had or for a change in class level (dropping from an honors level to a regular class). Once the school year begins, scheduling changes **must be made before the end of the second week of school.** However, it must be emphasized that the master schedule will have little flexibility for changes. **A parent signature will be required to drop academic, honors, IB and AP classes. TEACHER SELECTIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

INFORMATION FOR ALL GRADE LEVELS

Emergency Cards – Students **WILL NOT** be permitted to register without a completed card. **Each student must have a completed emergency card for our files.** Families should complete the emergency card, print, and bring it to registration.

Tdap Vaccine – Students **WILL NOT** be permitted to register without proof that they have had the whooping cough shot. **Each student must have proof of immunization on file.** If not provided earlier, families should bring official proof of immunization to registration.

Fines and Debts- Students **WILL NOT** be permitted to register without paying fines or debts. **Any student who owes a fine or has a debt from last year must pay the bill prior to registering.**

Free and Reduced Lunch Applications- An application form for free and reduced lunch can be printed from this website following July 1. Families should complete and bring to registration. A table will be present in the quad during registration to submit the applications.

ID Cards - Each student must have an ID picture taken on the assigned registration day. **Students MUST BE in possession of student ID when on campus, at school-sponsored activities or in order to receive school services (food service, library, ASB events, finance, athletic events, etc.)**

Student Insurance – Insurance for students is offered as an option for families. This is a coverage that can be added to existing family coverage or take the place of family coverage. For students who participate in V.U.S.D. extra-curricular activities or athletics programs, this coverage fulfills the requirement for medical coverage. Interested families should read the district *Student Injuries and Insurance Letter*. The *Student Accident and Health Insurance Brochure and Application form* can be picked up at RBV's front office.

Sports Schedule Changes- Sports/athletic PE changes will only be made after the counselor receives the team roster from the athletic director. Freshmen athletes will be placed in an athletic PE period ONLY after they have made the team.

Address Change- Anyone who has moved over the summer must present two sources to verify the change of address. Rental and/or lease agreements, gas and/or electric bills, final escrow papers and property tax bills are acceptable and must be with the student at registration.

Parent Portal- If parents established a parent portal account at any of the middle schools or high schools in the Vista Unified School District, they do not need to set up a new account. A Parent Portal account allows a parent with computer access to view the student's attendance and grades in real time. **Anyone who has not set up a parent portal account is encouraged to do so during registration.** Parents should print the *Parent Portal Application*, complete and bring to the RBV Data Processing office during registration.

Seniors

Senior Photos for the Yearbook-

- Jerry Bryan Studios in Carlsbad provides senior yearbook photos. Calls should be made to the studio at 760-434-3318 to make an appointment.
- Only photos taken by Jerry Bryan Studios will appear in the yearbook. There is no obligation to purchase packages of photos taken at Jerry Bryan Studios.
- Seniors must be in attendance during the fall semester for their photo to appear in the yearbook. To appear in the yearbook, photos must be taken (or retaken) by Jerry Bryan before October 14, 2011.
- A separate mailer regarding senior yearbook ads will be mailed home.

Lunch Pass Applications –Seniors may apply for an off campus lunch pass. *Students must have 2.0 GPA, a minimum score of 320 on the English or Math sections of the CST, no more than ten tardies or unexcused period cuts in the previous semester, administrative and parental approval.* Lunch Pass Applications should be printed, completed and submitted during registration. Stickers will be issued two weeks following the start of the year. There is a minimum 48 hour processing time for lunch permits submitted once school begins.

Parking permits –Senior Students may purchase a parking tag during registration. Parking permits cost \$25.00 with an ASB card and \$30.00 without. A separate parking tag must be purchased for each car a student drives. Parking tags will be placed on the car by RBV security during the first few weeks of school. Cars without a tag will be ticketed. **All tickets will be sent to an outside agency and must be paid through that agency only.** RBV has a limited number of parking spaces available for students. These spaces are reserved for Junior & Seniors ONLY.

Juniors

Yearbook Photos - Lifetouch Photography will be taking yearbook pictures for 11th grade students. Parents may purchase school pictures online. A link will be available on the RBV registration site. Only photos taken by Lifetouch Photography will appear in the yearbook.

Lunch Pass Applications –Juniors may apply for an off campus lunch pass. *Students must have 2.0 GPA, a minimum score of 320 on the English or Math sections of the CST, no more than ten tardies or unexcused period cuts in the previous semester, administrative and parental approval.* Lunch Pass Applications should be printed, completed and submitted during registration. Stickers will be issued two weeks following the start of the year. There is a minimum 48 hour processing time for lunch permits submitted once school begins.

Parking permits –Junior students may purchase a parking tag during registration. Parking permits cost \$25.00 with an ASB card and \$30.00 without. A separate parking tag must be purchased for each car a student drives. Parking tags will be placed on the car by RBV security during the first few weeks of school. Cars without a tag will be ticketed. **All tickets will be sent to an outside agency and must be paid through that agency only.** RBV has a limited number of parking spaces available for students. These spaces are reserved for Junior & Seniors ONLY.

Sophomores

Yearbook Photos - Lifetouch Photography will be taking yearbook pictures for 10th grade students. Parents may purchase school pictures online. A link will be available on the RBV registration site. Only photos taken by Lifetouch Photography will appear in the yearbook.

Parking permits- Since RBV has a limited number of parking spaces, sophomores are not allowed parking passes.

Freshmen

Yearbook Photos - Lifetouch Photography will be taking yearbook pictures for 9th grade students. Parents may purchase school pictures online. A link will be available on the RBV registration site. Only photos taken by Lifetouch Photography will appear in the yearbook.

Athletic PE- 9th grade students will be placed in an athletic PE (sport) class only after the team roster has been posted and they have officially become a member of the team.

Ninth graders will register for classes on Wednesday, August 10th. An introduction to the RBV campus, culture, and mentorship program will take place during the registration process. Students should allow 90 minutes for the registration/orientation session. For assigned registration time per alpha break, families should consult the *Registration Dates and Times* chart on the website.

Athletics/Co-Curricular Activities (ALL GRADES)

- All students involved in extra-curricular activities such as athletics, cheerleading, band and pageantry, ASB, and speech and debate are encouraged to purchase an ASB discount card.
- Participants in extra-curricula activities must maintain a 2.0 GPA.
- 9th grade students will be placed in an athletic PE (sport) class only after the team roster has been posted and they have officially become a member of the team.
